

Census Bureau Visits St. Mary OB Unit to Count April 1st Babies



(Long Beach, CA, April 1, 2010) The U.S. Census Bureau will count babies born on Thursday, April 1st in the 2010 Census. St. Mary Medical Center was selected as the area hospital to promote the importance of the Census. Officials from the Census Bureau visited the St. Mary Maternal Health Services Unit and presented the families of babies

born on April 1st with a shirt that says “I’m here. I Count. U. S. Census 2010.”
